Day 1

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Velkomin til Íslands!

Arrive at Keflavík International Airport in the morning, where your private transfer (9:30 AM) will be waiting to take you straight to one of the country's most iconic experiences.

Soak in the milky-blue geothermal waters of the Blue Lagoon with Premium admission. Relax amid volcanic landscapes as you shake off jet lag and get ready for the adventure ahead.

Enjoy a free afternoon to explore Iceland's vibrant capital—its colorful streets, art galleries, and the famous Hallgrímskirkja church.



Day 2

Golden Circle

Today we explore the world-famous Golden Circle, starting at Þingvellir National Park, where you'll walk between the tectonic plates of North America and Europe and visit the birthplace of one of the world's oldest parliaments (founded in 930).

In Laugarvatn, we'll bake traditional rye bread underground using geothermal heat—a tradition that even fascinated Gordon Ramsay.

Next, we visit Kerið volcanic crater and enjoy lunch at the Friðheimar greenhouses. We finish at the Geysir geothermal area, where Strokkur erupts every few minutes.

Day 3

Geothermal Highlands Adventure

We head deep into the Highlands to Hveradalir in Kerlingarfjöll—a surreal valley of colorful mountains, steaming vents, and bubbling hot springs. Enjoy a 2-hour hike through landscapes that feel truly other-worldly.

Later we visit Hveravellir, a geothermal oasis between the Langjökull and Hofsjökull glaciers, where you can relax in a natural hot pool before returning to Highland Base for another night of aurora hunting.



Epic Waterfalls & the South Coast

We visit the powerful Gullfoss (“Golden Falls”), where the Hvítá River plunges in two dramatic tiers into a canyon below. The roar of the water and the mist it creates are unforgettable.

We return to the Geysir area for a final look at the geysers in action.

Then we continue to Iceland’s South Coast to visit Seljalandsfoss, the iconic waterfall where you can walk behind the curtain of water. We explore the hidden Nauthúsagil canyon—a narrow, lush gorge with secret waterfalls tucked inside.

Day 5

Glacier Trek, Ice Caves & Dramatic Landscapes

We gear up with crampons, harness, helmet, and ice axe for a 4-hour hike on Sólheimajökull Glacier. Your expert guide will teach you about glacier formations, deep crevasses, and how to “read” the ice.

We'll enter a natural ice cave (subject to safe conditions). The glowing blue ice inside is one of the most breathtaking natural wonders on Earth.

We then explore the spectacular Fjaðrárgljúfur Canyon, with 100-meter-high walls and a winding river below—the same canyon made famous by Justin Bieber in a music video.

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Jökulsárlón: Iceberg Day

Today is dedicated to one of Iceland's greatest wonders: Jökulsárlón. In the glacier lagoon, massive icebergs drift across deep-blue water after breaking away from majestic Vatnajökull.

We cross to Diamond Beach, where chunks of ice wash up on volcanic black sand, sparkling like diamonds.


The most thrilling experience of the day is the Zodiac Tour among the icebergs, cruising close to the glacier face with the chance to spot seals resting on the ice. In the afternoon, we visit the more secluded Heinabergslón Lagoon, quieter and far less visited.


Day 7

Volcanic Landscapes & the Sky Lagoon Ritual

We cross the Eldhraun Lava Field, the largest lava flow in recorded history, now covered in vivid green moss that gives it an almost extraterrestrial look.

We also visit Hjørleifshöfði and the dramatic Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach, with its basalt columns and the striking Reynisdrangar sea stacks rising from the Atlantic.

We return to the capital to end the journey with a wellness experience at Sky Lagoon and its signature 7-Step Ritual—one last geothermal soak with ocean views.

PASSPORT VALIDITY: At least 6 months beyond your departure date from Iceland.

At least 2 blank pages.

TOURIST ENTRY AUTHORIZATION: Mexican and U.S. citizens will need an ETIAS authorization to enter Iceland and the Schengen Area.

CASH RESTRICTIONS: Mandatory declaration if carrying more than €10,000 in cash.

SIM CARD / INTERNET:

Airalo works excellently in Iceland.



Alternative: Purchase a local SIM at the airport.

CREDIT CARDS:

Cards are accepted everywhere—even for small purchases.

CASH:

Optional, but it's useful to carry some.

You can exchange at the airport or withdraw from ATMs.

Icelandic Króna (ISK)
